GT DRAGON BOAT SOCIETY – Safety Guidelines

Members using GT boats or equipment, or participating in any GT event shall observe the International Dragon Boat Federation Water Safety Policy and the Canadian Coast Guard Safe Boating Guide. (www.tc.gc.ca/boatingsafety and www.idbf.org/library/safety)

Approved Personal Flotation Devices must be worn properly at all paddling events.

Use of alcohol or drugs of any kind are strictly forbidden by anyone using GTDBS equipment.

The boat will always have a Safety Kit* on board, and paddlers will be instructed on a safe rescue of an overboard paddler and a capsized boat.

All group outings must have a designated GT leader.

All members and guests must sign the GTDBS membership waiver before paddling. In addition a Par-Q (physical activity readiness questionnaire) must be completed, signed and witnessed.

Paddlers and Steers who are 70 years of age or older are required to provide written approval from their personal physician prior to participating.

* A Safety Kit consists of a heaving line, bailers, air horn and First Aid Kit.
